This consultation

- Through this consultation we are inviting comments about the new and altered services we are introducing in December 2017 as the first phase of Northern's transformation of its timetable.
- This consultation has been timed to allow us to reflect the responses in our formal timetable submission to Network Rail in March.
- This consultation covers the timetable which will run from December 2017 until May 2018.
- We are planning much more substantial changes for the May 2018 timetable. We will consult these separately later this year and we look forward to working with our stakeholders to develop a timetable that drives growth and prosperity across our region

Our approach to December 17 development

- Exploits benefits of electrification through deployment of electric trains delivering improved running times
- Redeploys cascaded diesel trains to provide benefits across the north
- Introduces a new service over the Ordsall Chord ultimately linking Manchester Victoria, Oxford Road, Piccadilly and Manchester Airport
- Introduces additional services on a handful of routes where:
 - self-contained changes can be made without affecting other services
 - changes will not be reversed or significantly altered in May 18

Transformation of train services across the north

- The December 2017 timetable marks the start of a phased programme of benefits to be delivered to customers as part of Northern Programmes.
- The Northern Programmes will transform rail transport in the north delivering more trains with more spaces to more towns and cities.
- From December 2017 there will be improved services, including electric trains with more space for customers running between Manchester and Preston via Bolton.
- Further service improvements are planned for the May 2018 timetable change.

December 2017 changes – a summary

The changes in December will realise the customer benefits of new infrastructure delivered as part of Network Rail's extensive Northern Programmes which includes:

- Electrification of the Bolton Corridor between Manchester and Preston
- Introduction of the Ordsall
 Chord which provides a direct
 link between Manchester
 Victoria and Manchester
 Airport



Electrification of the Bolton Corridor allows electric rolling stock to be used on this route for the first time. This in turn allows the displaced diesel trains to be used elsewhere across our network providing opportunities to introduce new and enhanced services.

December 2017 changes – a summary


- Faster journey times and higher capacity electric rolling stock on Bolton corridor services
- 'Cascade' of diesel rolling stock to enable service enhancements elsewhere, including:
 - Hourly West Yorkshire Manchester Oxford Road
 - Hourly Bishop Auckland Darlington
 - Two service per hour between Sheffield, Worksop and Retford
 - Improved journey times between Sheffield and Lincoln
 - 4 tph Harrogate Leeds
- We will also introduce enhancements to Sunday services on a number of routes.



A Stepping stone to May 18 and beyond

The changes we will introduce in December 17 are the first steps on the road to the full transformation of Northern's trains service:

- May 18 electrification of the Bolton corridor, capacity improvements between Manchester Victoria and Stalybridge together with the arrival of more rolling stock will enable the introduction of significant, further enhancements.
- December 18 the phased introduction of new build rolling stock will commence during the December 18 timetable
- December 19 Northern Connect will create a new network of longer distance, faster services meeting the needs of passengers right across the offering better customer service, on- board facilities and seat reservations.



Throughout the process we will work with Network Rail, and other operators to provide the best possible service connections at key nodes by December 2019.

Leeds – Bradford – Manchester Oxford Road (via new Ordsall Chord)

Making use of the newly opened Ordsall Chord we will introduce an hourly, offpeak service between Leeds and Bradford to Manchester Oxford Road. This service represents a stepping stone to the May 2018 timetable change where that service will be extended through central Manchester and onto the Airport.

Summary

One service per hour to/from Bradford Interchange and Leeds via Calder Valley is extended to/from Manchester Oxford Road.

A small number of peak additional services between Rochdale and Manchester Victoria.

In westbound direction the xx:18 from Leeds (xx:41 from Bradford Interchange) extends to Manchester Oxford Road

In eastbound direction an xx:38 starts at Manchester Oxford Road, departing Manchester Victoria xx:48 and arriving in Bradford Interchange at xx:46 and Leeds at xx:10.

Sheffield - Retford - Lincoln

In introducing a twice hourly service and thereby doubling the frequency between Sheffield and Retford we are able to adjust the calling patterns to provide a faster service between Sheffield and Lincoln.

Summary

Services depart Sheffield at (broadly) xx:28 and xx:44.

xx:28 calls all stations to Retford.

xx:44 fast to Worksop than calls Retford, Gainsborough Lea Road, Saxilby and Lincoln Central.

Journey time between Sheffield and Lincoln of xx:44 proposed to be 1hr 13 minutes

Equivalent pattern in opposite direction.

December 2017 changes – Sundays

We propose to introduce or enhance Sunday services on the following routes.

- Morpeth Newcastle
 provision of a local service for Manors and Cramlington as well as more services
 to/from Morpeth, most of which will operate from/to Metrocentre
- Newcastle Carlisle
 the hours of operation will be extended meaning an additional two extra trains in each direction will operate. We will also introduce a more standardised pattern of calls at stations between Hexham and Carlisle.
- Bishop Auckland Darlington
 provision of an hourly service, most of which will operate to/from Middlesbrough and
 Saltburn
- Middlesbrough Whitby

 a year round provision of a (broadly) hourly service between Middlesbrough and
 Nunthorpe in conjunction with 4 trains each way between Middlesbrough and
 Whitby. Majority of services will operate from/to Newcastle via Sunderland. We are currently planning that the Sunday service will continue, without a break from the end of the Summer season 2017.

December 2017 changes – Sundays

- Skipton / Ilkley Bradford FS
 Increase to an hourly service
- Knaresborough/Harrogate Leeds
 provision of a half-hourly service Leeds Knaresborough 1000 to 2000, with earlier
 travel opportunities into Leeds and York
- Lincoln Sheffield
 provision of an hourly service Sheffield Lincoln from 0840 to 2120, including
 morning travel opportunity into Sheffield and Meadowhall
- Wigan Manchester
 provision of two services per hour via Atherton 0900 to 1800 and a new hourly
 evening service until 2200
- Wigan Liverpool
 provision of a half-hourly service Wigan Liverpool from 0930 to 1900
- Preston Colne
 provision of an hourly service Blackpool South (when line reopens in March) –
 Preston Colne 0900 to 2000

Boxing Day services

Northern is reviewing opportunities to operate services on Boxing Day.

Traditionally this has not been viable due to the costs of route opening, and in particular the costs of opening multiple signal boxes along a line of route.

As Network Rail signalling control becomes more centralised there may be new opportunities.

We would welcome suggestions from Stakeholders together with supporting evidence and justification to inform development of options.

Works between Preston and Blackpool

Between November 2017 and March 2018 the route to Blackpool North is closed with replacement road transport provided. This is to undertake electrification works on the route.

The block is in two phases:

- 1. From **11/11/2017** to **26/01/2018** there will be no train services from either Blackpool North or Blackpool South through to Preston.
- 2. From **27/01/2018** to **25/03/2018** a train service will operate from Blackpool South to Preston. The line between Blackpool North and Kirkham and Wesham will remain blocked.

From **26/03/2018** the full route will be re-opened, but will only be available for diesel services.

For the period between 11th November 2017 and 19th May 2018, through services to Manchester Airport will not operate.

From **20/05/2018** the route will be energised and will be served by electric trains, enabling the restoration of through services to Liverpool and Manchester.
